Professor Michael Bratychak has completed his PhD in 1980 and DSc (in chemical science) in 1990 from Lviv Polytechnic National University. He is the Head of Petroleum and Gas Chemistry and Technology Department of the same University from 1994. He has published about 20 books, 560 scientific publications in Ukrainian, American, Polish, Czech and Russian Journals, 54 Patents and Author's Certificates. Advisor to 34 works for Master Degree, 20 for PhD thesis and 2 for Doctoral thesis. Since 1996 he is an Academician of Ukrainian Oil and Gas Academy (UOGA) and Head of the Division of Petrochemistry of UOGA.
